<u>Credits</u>

- How many credits are required for graduation? 24
- How do students earn credits? .5 credit is earned for every semester class when students earn a "D" or higher.
- If students fails a specific course do they have to repeat that exact course? Only if it is a
 specific course required for graduation (ex. US History, Civics, World History, Algebra I,
 Geometry and Health) Otherwise they just need to earn the number of required credits
 per subject area.
- What are the options for making up a credit for a class that was failed? Students can retake a course during Summer Academy, retake the course the following year, or take a similar online course through Pearson Connexus during the school year.
- Will HS courses taken at the middle school be automatically added to their transcripts? Yes credit bearing courses completed in MS will be automatically be jump started.

Summer School

- How do I sign my student up for summer school? <u>Summer Programs Central Kitsap Schools</u>
- How many summer courses can students sign up for? You can only sign up for one at a
 time (with the hope that you finish 1 and have time to complete another course before
 August) If you sign up for PE 1A you can only take 1 course

Sports

- How many Sport Seasons are there? 3 (Fall, Winter, Spring)
- Can an athlete play more than one sport at a time? No
- What sports do you have? Activities & Athletics Central Kitsap High School
- How much does it cost to play a sport? \$75 and must have ASB Card.

Alternate choices

- How many alternates do I pick? Every class with an * requires an alternate. If it is a 1.0 (year long) you need a 1.0 or two .5 (semester) classes.
- Do I need an alternate for a World Language class? An alternate is needed for all first year World Languages classes, but not for 2nd year and beyond.
- Should my alternate classes be the same subject type? It is not required, but when thinking about meeting graduation requirements it makes sense. PE choice PE alt.
- Can I select the same course as an alternate that I picked as a first choice to ensure I
 get it? No, If it doesn't fit for some reason you will need a different choice.

West Sound Tech Skills Center

- When can students sign up for WST? Must be going into 11th or 12th grade.
- How many classes do you take at CK if you are attending WST? 3 periods at WST and 3 Periods at CK (which periods depend on AM/PM schedule at WST).
- If I'm a Sophomore wanting to do WST do I need to sign up for 6 classes at CK? Yes, please sign up for a full 6 classes and we will adjust your schedule once you are in WST.

Running Start

- When can students participate in the RS program? Junior or Senior year.
- Are there GPA requirements for RS? Must have a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

- Can students take classes at CK and OC? Yes, but the total number of classes is based on an FTE sliding scale. (Caution: start and end times of terms don't match up)
- If I don't test into college level courses can I still participate in the program? Students
 must pay for any class that is below 100 level. If you don't test into Math and English it
 might be best not to be a RS student; however, you can still take classes as a "Limited
 Access" student.

- What do students need to do to be a Distinguished Scholar?

- Can a student be a distinguished scholar if they are a running start student? Yes

Unique Courses and Auditions

Some courses at CKHS require an application or an audition, be sure to read each course description carefully.

- When will jazz band and jazz choir auditions be held? Sometime this spring. Mr. Woods and Ms. Redenko will publish those dates and times.
- Do students need to audition for Wind ensemble? Yes, unless they were in the class the previous year.
- What choir should I sign up for if I'm an incoming freshman? Females should sign up for treble choir, and males should sign up for advanced choir. Adjustments will be made after auditions.

PE and Health

- How many credits of PE do students need? .5 health and 1.5 fitness.
- If I play sports can it count for PE? No, there is no credit attached to sports.
- If I play sports can I waive a .5 PE credit? Yes, after completing Health and Intro (PE 1A) upon successful completion of a HS sport season you can request a PE Sports Waiver from your counselor.
- Can students do all PE in the summer or online? Yes
- Can students take both PE and Health in the same summer? No, PE has a 10 week fitness log requirement and will not allow any time to take an addition course.
