Parking Rules Acknowledgement 2019-2020

In order to obtain parking privileges in the CKHS student lots, each student must officially register their vehicle. In addition each student and their parent/guardian(s) must sign this form.

Students must complete registration paperwork

- Students must possess a current Driver's License.
- The school-issued parking permit must be clearly displayed on the rear-view mirror with the permit number facing toward the windshield. Failure to clearly display the parking permit in this manner will constitute a violation. Because we have problems with students who hand their passes to others for display, even though a student has a registered permit, failure to display properly will always result in a violation.
- If the student uses another family vehicle on occasion, the student is responsible for transferring his/her permit to their alternate REGISTERED vehicle. Failure to transfer the permit also constitutes a violation.
- The hanging of excess paraphernalia (i.e. Hawaiian leis) from the rearview mirror is unadvisable as it commonly obscures the permit from view and can lead to undue citations.
- If your vehicle has tinting on its windshield, please affix the permit so the number is easily visible.

The Central Kitsap School District is not responsible for damage or theft from vehicles parked on school grounds. Adult security personnel and security cameras make every effort to protect the lots from vandalism, but cannot provide complete security or responsibility for vehicle damage or theft. Students who park in the CKHS lots assume the normal risks associated with parking lots.

Citation System:

It is imperative that students understand the parking rules for CKHS. Failure to comply will result in the following progressive citation system:

*First Offense:	Citation \$ 5.00 fine incurred (<i>see exceptions below</i>)
*Second Offense:	Citation \$15.00 fine incurred
*Third and all subsequent Offenses:	Citation \$30.00 fine incurred and possible vehicle immobilization (Tire Clamp)

***Student vehicles parked in fire lanes, staff parking, visitor parking, behind the weight room or in any other "no parking" areas may be clamped and will be assessed a \$30 fine even on the first offense. STUDENTS ARE PROHIBITED FROM PARKING IN STAFF LOTS UNTIL AFTER 4:00. TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL 4:00.**

THESE FINES ARE GIVEN EACH TIME THE OFFENSE OCCURS.

Students caught using or assisting in the production of forgeries of CKHS parking tags will be subject to revocation of their parking privileges and/or a maximum fine of \$100.

Students may not share or give their parking pass to other students. Parking passes are non-transferable between student vehicles. Students caught sharing parking passes will be subject to revocation of parking privileges and/or a maximum fine of \$100.

NO preference will be given to students attending CKHS on non-resident status (i.e. students who live outside CKHS boundaries and are attending CKHS on a transfer letter).

Running Start, Skills Center and part-time students must secure their parking privileges BEFORE they register for classes. Running Start students must schedule classes at O.C.C. so that they have ample time to drive safely and use the appropriate CKHS student parking lot. Running Start students and students coming from and going to the Skills Center may not park in staff and visitor parking even for a short transitional time.

Students with off campus activities such as athletics are prohibited from parking in staff or visitor parking during school hours unless they are given a temporary pass from a school administrator.

Students wishing to appeal fines or citations may appeal to the CKHS Main Office within thirty days of the issuance of the citation.
