*Personalized Pathway Requirement (PPR), related to courses that lead to a specific post-high school career or educational outcome chosen by the student based on the student's interests and High School and Beyond Plan, which may include CTE and are intended to provide a focus for the student's learning.

In addition to the above credit requirements, students must complete a High School and Beyond Plan. Students must also pass the state-required assessments or a state-approved alternative.

These are minimum requirements required for graduation. We encourage all students to achieve beyond these minimum requirements.
