NROTC APPLICATION PROCESS

- Complete Online Application
(<http://www.nrotc.navy.mil/apply.aspx>)
(Must click on Marine Corps Option)
- Apply to NROTC college/university
- Complete application package with recruiter
- Attend a Processing Day to complete package
- Selection board convenes
- Applicant notified of board results

1. Google NROTC
2. Apply Tab
3. Application Login (**Must select Marine Option. Cannot apply for both Navy and Marine Option**)
4. Will then direct you to NETFOCUS

Applicants must use the online application to complete and submit all the required information in order to apply for the Navy ROTC scholarship.


This online application is extensive and may require several hours to complete. You are able to start the application and save your progress as you complete each section. We have provided an Application Information Checklist to assist you in gathering information and to streamline the process of applying for a scholarship.

Applicants are asked to pick five Navy ROTC affiliated colleges or universities in their scholarship application. Each school must be for a different Navy ROTC Unit and one of the top three choices must be a state school where they qualify to receive an in-state tuition rate, not necessarily in the applicant's home state.

Each applicant must also select an academic program in which they intend to major. All academic programs fall into [three tiers](#)



AUGUST/SEPTEMBER PROCESSING DAYS

Saturday 31 August @ RECRUITING STATION SEATTLE

Saturday 28 September @ RECRUITING SUB STATION MISSOULA

YOU MAY PROCESS AT ANY RECRUITING SUB STATION. Officer Interviews are preferably in-person but Skype is acceptable by exception.

PROCESSING DAYS

- CONSISTS OF:
 - Photo in business attire (clean background / POA)
 - PFT
 - Height / Weight
 - Package scrub (Conducted by Marines while XO interviews)
 - Interview (2 Officers)

- WHAT THE APPLICANT NEEDS:
 - Water source.
 - Must arrive in business attire.
 - Applicant needs to have a change of PT clothes.
 - Birth Certificate
 - Physician Approval Form **MANDATORY**
 - Parental Approval Form (Under 18) **MANDATORY**
 - Hold Harmless Agreement **MANDATORY**
 - Completed package that has been reviewed by SNCOIC



TRENDS/RECOMMENDATIONS

- PAPERWORK:
 - Teacher Evals incomplete
 - SAT/ACT verifications missing
 - Transcripts missing or unofficial
 - Birth Certificates missing

- PHYSICAL:
 - Crunches technique.
 - Pull-up technique.
 - If males are opting to do pushups then they wont be physically qualified.
 - Applicants need to have a 260 or over to be physically competitive.
 - The more PFTs they run, the better.
 - Should be involved in as many sports as possible.
